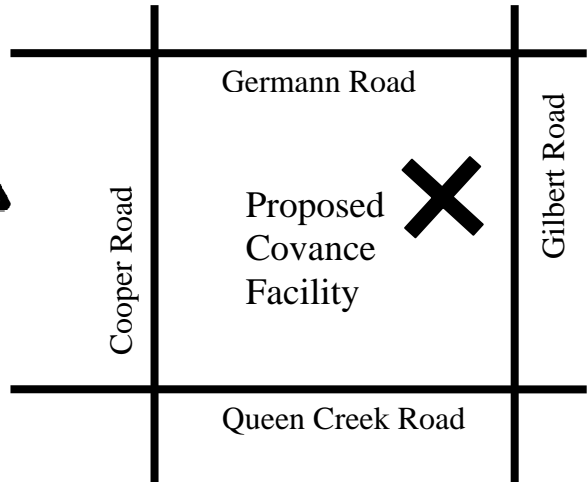


PUBLIC HAZARD

Potential Outbreak of Ebola and Other Dangerous Pathogens Places Chandler Residents at Risk!



New Jersey-based animal testing conglomerate Covance is the largest importer of primates into the U.S. and the biggest breeder of dogs for use in experimentation. The company now plans to build a new lab in Chandler!

- **Disease Importer**: Covance imported over 12,000 monkeys into the U.S. in 2005. The company has also imported a number of shipments of Ebola-infected monkeys over the years; in fact in 1989 there was an accidental outbreak of the Ebola virus at their facility in Reston, VA. Medical military personnel in Hazmat suits marched in to seal and sanitize the facility. Covance abandoned the contaminated building, leaving homeowners in the area with blight and falling property values.
- **Polluter**: Covance plans to build an incinerator in Chandler which will dispose of the estimated quarter million animals they will kill every year.
- **Animal Abuser**: Covance was recently cited and fined for serious violations of the Animal Welfare Act. In 2005 alone, five Covance facilities in the U.S. were found to be in violation of the Animal Welfare Act.
- **Bad Neighbor**: In 2000, Covance tried to build a new lab in Alameda, CA, but public opposition was so fierce, Covance withdrew their application.
